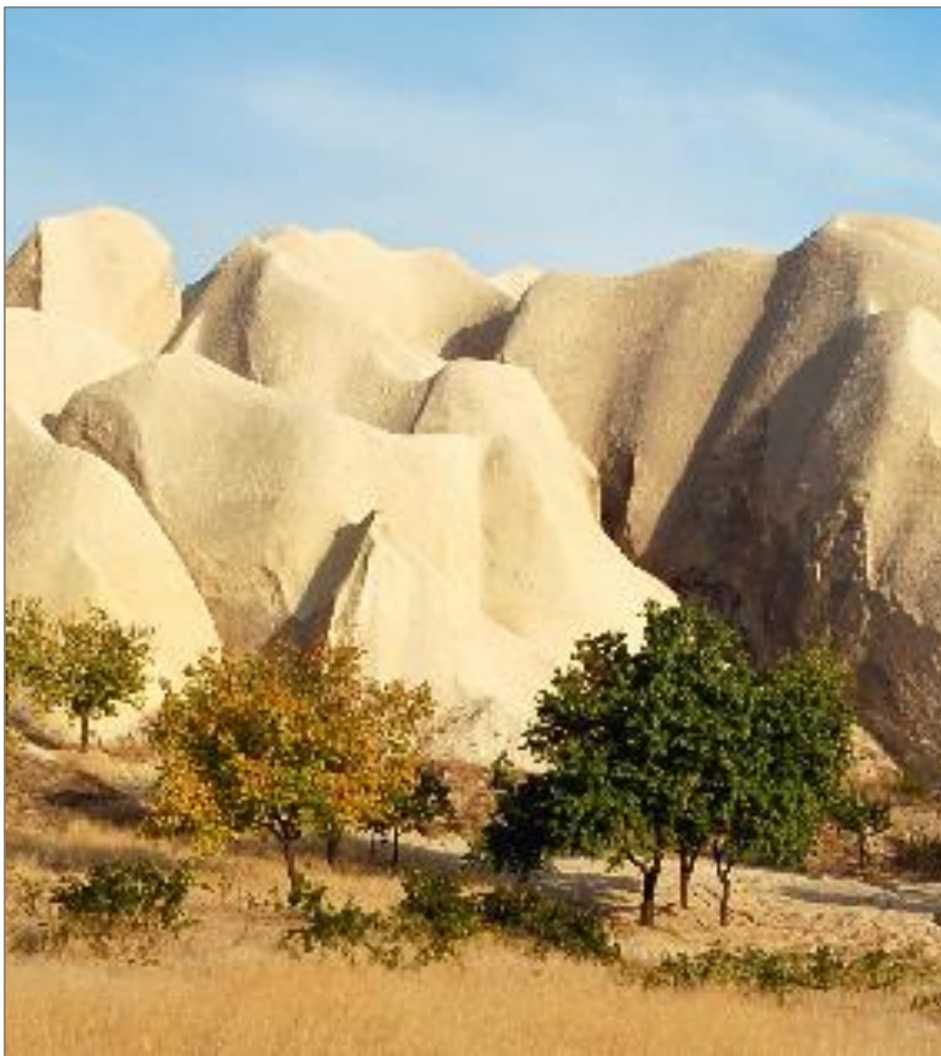

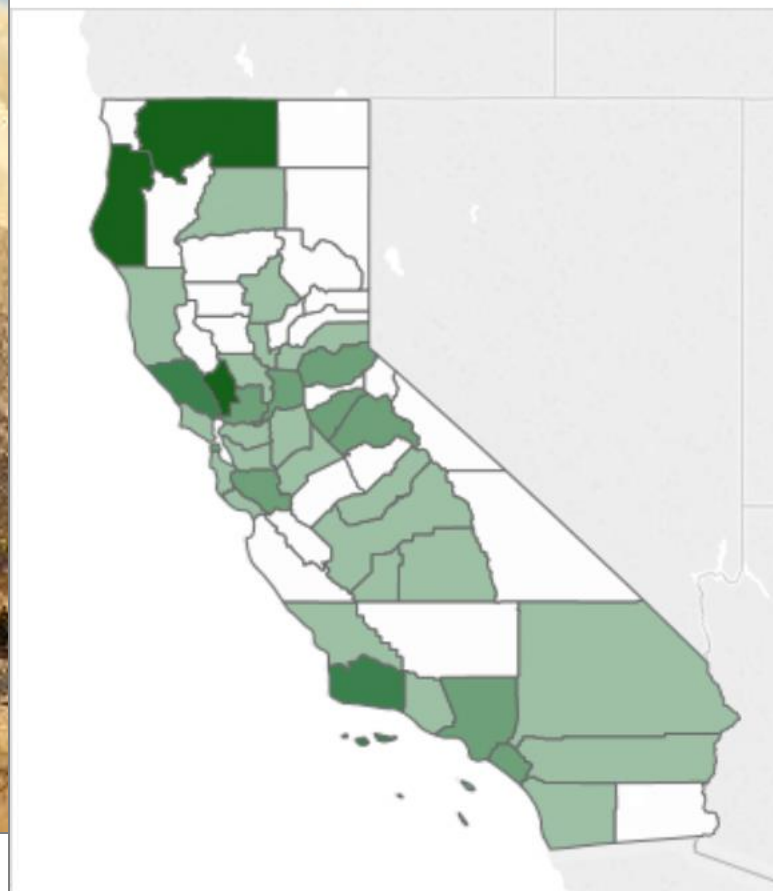
CHCF opportunities

- While hospital-based programs are established, community-based palliative care (CBPC) is emerging
 - People with advanced illness live in the community
 - Data shows gap between need and capacity
 - Evidence base developing on value
 - SB 1004 presents unique CA opportunity

Working with payers and providers

- Opportunity for CHCF – close gap
 - Stimulate development of community based models
 - Test different payment strategies
 - Serve as a model for state and nation
- Support development of new palliative care programs
 - Six pairs of payers and providers
 - Based on 6-month planning process (2014)
 - Pilot tests that spread

- Secure leadership buy-in – payers and providers
- Provide expert resources and faculty
- Support implementation efforts
 - Project management at team level
 - Grantee meetings
 - Evaluation
- Medi-Cal Pilot – Partnership HealthPlan of CA
- Dissemination – CHCF and participants
